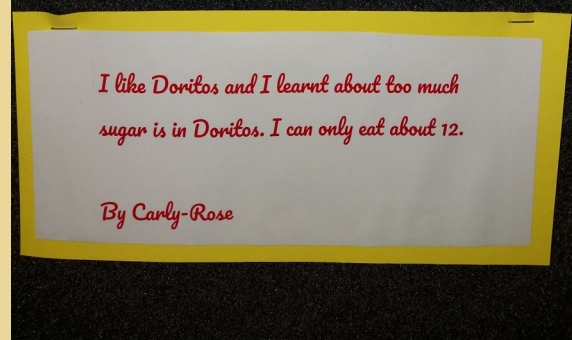
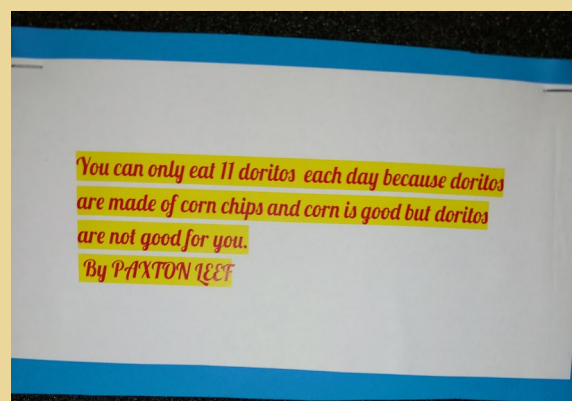
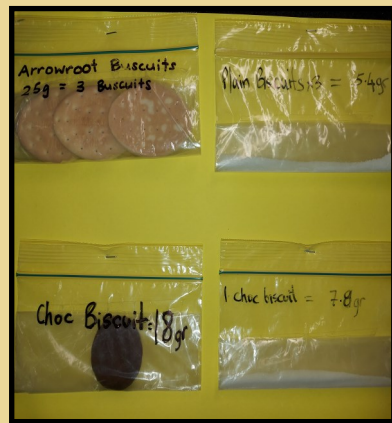




MIDDLE SYNDICATE NEWS FROM ROOM 12:

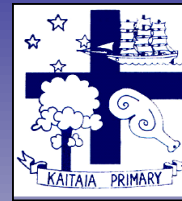

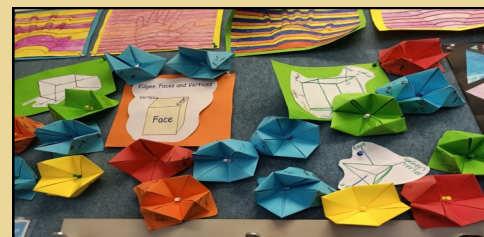

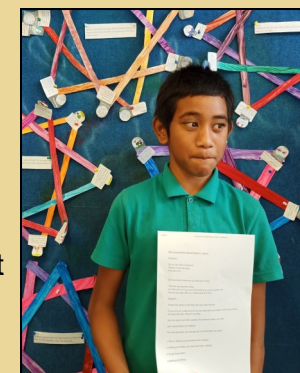
NZSL was celebrated throughout the school. Room 21 enjoyed learning Tiki Taane song 'No place like home'



Geometry was our focus in math.



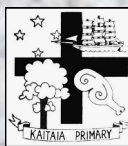
Speeches were written.... Tyson wrote about why we should be allowed bikes at school.
